Adapting to mitigate hazards is critical in construction. To address challenges posed by COVID-19, LeChase quickly enacted a number of measures to keep projects open and operating safely while we continue to monitor specific guidelines set by our industry and safety experts. New measures include more frequent disinfection of handrails and high-touch surfaces, preventative testing protocols, new PPE use, and strict hygiene and distancing practices to guard against person-to-person spread. In addition, teams are assessing each project's individual needs – like staggered schedules to reduce the number of people working in tight spaces. Having started in the southeast, where many projects have been ongoing, the measures are moving across the company as projects reopen.
